May 26, 1874

News of death of MRS. J. F. PARKER nee JULIA HART reached Tuscaloosa by telegraph from Milen, Gilson Co. Tenn. where deceased lived. Born and reared in this place, only daughter of MRS. S. O. HART. She appeared in Baptist Church as a bride July 15, 1873...

Death of MRS. RICHARD H. CLARK nee MISS MARY BURKE formerly of Tuscaloosa. Died at her home in Linden, Marengo Co.

June 16, 1874

Died in North Port very suddenly MRS. E. NORIS, nee MISS CHRISTIAN.

In Tuscaloosa on 10, LYDIA, daughter of PROF. and MRS. D. L. PECK aged about 14 months.

In Tuscaloosa on night of 8 of typhoid fever, MISS VIRGINIA DONOHO, daughter of MR. and MRS. MONROE DONOHO.

In Tuscaloosa on 4 at residence of her brother-in-law, DR. JOHN LITTLE, SR. MISS MARY KERR aged about 74.

July 21, 1874

Married at Catholic Church in Tuscaloosa on morning of 11 by REV. FATHER KIRWIN, MR. CON MURPHY to MISS JENNIE RAYMOND, all of Tuscaloosa.

August 22, 1874

Died in Tuscaloosa on Sun 3, JOHN A. WYNN, Esq. in 79th year. Highly esteemed and worthy citizen.

September 26, 1874

Died suddenly in Eutaw on Mon. morning 21, A. S. NICOLSON, Esq. Man of ability, superior attainments as a scholar, excellent lawyer, gentleman. Remains brought to this city yesterday and interred in our city cemetery.

October 10, 1874

Died suddenly at residence of DR. JOHN MARRAST near Tuscaloosa on 2, MARRAST STURDIVANT aged 12 years, son of MRS. IDA STURDIVANT and a grandson of DR. MARRAST.

October 24, 1874

Died in this city on 18, MRS. SARAH SIMS, relict of the late FRANK SIMS, aged 83...

Died on 15 at her late residence 2 mi. from Tuscaloosa, MRS. E. A. EDDINS, relict of the late CAPT. J. B. EDDINS (only confederate soldier killed here by Yankees when a Croxton raid occurred)...Baptist.

Died at her late residence near this city on 19, after a lingering illness MRS. SARAH W. BAIRD (47 of Va.; wid of ALEX BAIRD) aged 71...

In Northport on 14 of bilious fever, ROBERT ADAMS aged about 17, son of the late REV. ROBERT ADAMS, formerly of this co.

At his residence in this co. on 19, RUFUS H. WILLINGHAM aged 28. Mason.

Died in Birmingham on eve. of 16 of typhoid fever, MR. A. J. SILVEY in 24th year.

November 16, 1874

Died on night of 7th, MRS. SARAH RICHARDSON. Born in Ky. Dec. 1785, consequently was nearly 89 years of age. Left 3 sons. all distinguished scholars. A. W., W. C. and W. G. RICHARDSON. (Is this the same SARAH RICHARDSON who belonged to Gilgal Bapt Church?)
