Died, MRS. CAROLINE M. McCALLEY, wife of MR. THOMAS S. McCALLEY at the residence of her husband in this vicinity Friday the 14th after a painful illness of two or three months in her 55th year. Funeral took place at the church of Nativity Sunday evening last REV. DR. BANISTER officiating. Native of this county, daughter of ROBERT LANFORD, one among the oldest settlers in Madison County.
