Died on the 8th at his residence near Jackson, Mississippi after an illness of several weeks, COL. JOHN J. LOCKHART, formerly a citizen of North Alabama.

Departed this life on 2nd instant, MRS. MARY ANN TRUE, wife of MR. ROBERT TRUE of Madison County, Alabama. MRS.
