On Tuesday 26 April by JOHN T. HADEN, Esq., MR. ROBT. H. OWEN to MISS OBEDIENCE A. CHILDRESS--all of this county (volume 53, page 10).

Died at his residence in this county on 19th instant, MR. PLEASANT STRONG, son of GEORGE and MARY STRONG, and was born in Goochland County, Virginia 14th July 1798. Moved in 1806 to Davidson County, Tennessee and from there to Bedford County 1807. In 1819 he removed to Lauderdale County, Alabama, where he remained until 1822 during which year he settled in this county, where he spent remainder of his life.
