March 5, 1856

Married on 21st by REV. H. P. TURNER, MR. GEORGE W. HUMPHREY and MISS ELLIE ROGERS, all of this county.

Married on 19th February 1856 by REV. WILLIAM J. HOLT, MR. THOMAS J. VANN to MISS SARAH M. SANDERS, all of this county.

Married at Powellton (Corsa County), Alabama on 21st by REV. MR. PHELAN (married LAURA POWELL, sister of COL. JAS. R. POWELL), JAMES H. WEAVER, Esq., Secretary of State of Alabama to MISS MAGGIE E. POWELL. (1850 Coosa County: POWELL, CATHERINE R. 57 in Virginia; JAMES R(OBT.), 35 in Virginia; MARGARET E., 24 in Virginia; ALLISON, 17 in Virginia; Coron County marriages--JAMES H. WEAVER--MARGARET E. WEAVER 20 February 1856)

Married on 21st by ELDER J. SEALS, MR. JOHN P. FARRAR to MISS ABIGAIL T. CRENSHAW, all of Limestone County (1850 census shows him aged 18 in Alabama; her 14 in Alabama).

Married on 19th by REV. D. L(?) or D(?) MITCHELL, MR. STRODDER A. McWILLIAMS to MISS NARCISSA M., daughter of JAS. HARGROVE, all of Limestone County. (note: looks like "STRANDER A" in census, aged 14 born in Alabama; Prob. Min. 1865, page 16; MRS. NARCISSA McWILLIAMS filed petition--estate of STRANDER McWILLIAMS, deceased; it's STROTHER in marriage record)

Married on 24th by JOHN TURRENTINE, Esq., MR. JESSE RAMBO to MISS EALANDER H. (A?) BRADSHAW, all of Limestone County (married 2 February; volume 223, page 60).

Died in Bellefonte on 24th, MR. JOHN W. CROMER of pneumonia.

March 12, 1856

Died at his own residence in Madison County, Alabama on night of 19th February 1856, JOHN L. KING, son of JOHN KING, on 20th before his burial, his funeral was preached by REV. M. H. BONE. JOHN L. KING was born December 28, 1825, married February 1851 and departed this life at above named time aged 31 years 1 month and some days. Professed religion in 1846 and joined the Cumberland Presbyterian Church. (1850 census shows him aged 24, born in Alabama; his father 72 in North Carolina)

March 19, 1856

Married on 9th by E. S. MASTERSON, Esq., MR. A(LEX M.) N. SMITH to MRS. LEONORA NeSMITH, all of Lawrence County (WPA Copy Lawrence County, Alabama; ALEXANDER M. SMITH to LOUISA NESMITH March 9, 1856).

Married on 5th by REV. FRANK KIMBLE, MR. R(ICHARD) B. NEVILL of Morgan County to MISS AMERICA W. BRUNDIDGE of Limestone County (volume 223, page 60). (1850 census shows her aged 13, born in Alabama; daughter of JAMES M. BRUNDIDGE)

Married on 28th by REV. DR. EDGAR, DR. JOSEPH A. DUNCAN of Branwell (Barnwell? C. H., South Carolina and MISS MADILINE ALLISON, daughter of S. D. MORGAN of Nashville).

Married on 5th by GEO. RUSSELL, Esq., MR. ANDREW WOODEY to MISS MARTHA WATTERSON, all of this county.

MR. MARTIN G. MILLIGAN married MRS. HYPASIA H. COLLIER. (1850 census shows her 36 in Alabama, widow of GREEN A. COLLIER.)

Married, MR. GILES SANDIDGE to MISS SARAH WILLIAMS.

Died in this place on 15th after a short illness, LUTHER, youngest child of MR. WM. D. HOLLOWELL, aged about 4 years.

Died in Elkton, Tennessee on the 6th, MAJ. ROBERT B. HARNEY.

Married in Columbus (Muscogee County), Georgia on 8th, OLIVER TOWLES, formerly of this place.

Died after a short illness on 9th at advanced age of 77 years, PETER LOONEY for many years a citizen of Lawrence County. (1850 census shows him aged 69 in South Carolina)

March 26, 1856

Married on 25th February by REV. J. R. MORRIS, MR. MILAS RUSSELL to MISS LUCINDA H. SHOOK, all of Jackson County.

Married on the 16th by HON. M. GILBREATH, MR. JAMES CRUTCHER to MISS E. R. PHILLIPS, all of Marshall County.
