

November 30, 1831

Married on the 10th of November, SAMUEL PROCTER, Esq. to MISS MARGARET DONOTHON, daughter of the REV. MR. DONOTHON, all of Jackson County, Alabama (see 1850 census of Jackson County, Alabama).

January 9, 1833

Married at Gunter's Landing, Alabama on the 1st day of November 1832, by the REV. C. PUTNAM, MR. BENJAMIN HENSLEY to MISS CATHARINE AIKEN, all of McMinn County, Tennessee.

June 12, 1833

Died on Saturday the 25th instant, after a long and painful illness, MRS. SARAH E. McCLUNG, daughter of JOHN MITCHELL, Esq., late Governor of Georgia, and consort of JAMES W. McCLUNG, Esq. of that town (Huntsville Southern Advocate).

July 24, 1833

Died at his late residence in the vicinity of Florence, Alabama on the 8th instant, GENERAL JOHN COFFEE, a distinguished officer of the late war, in the 62nd year of his age.

August 21, 1833

Died of consumption at the Knoxville Hotel on Thursday the 15th instant, CESAR COCLOUGH, Esq. of Montgomery, Alabama.

August 28, 1833

Married in Clinton on the 22nd instant by the REV. SAMUEL LOWE, MR. JOHN W. RUTLAND (RUTLAND?; 41 in North Carolina) of Madison County, Alabama to MISS MARGARET ANN BARTON (37 in Tennessee), daughter of DOCTOR HUGH BARTON (76 in Virginia; ancestor of MRS. MARY LOLLAR, Tuscaloosa, Alabama 1956).

September 25, 1833

Married in this town on the 11th instant, by the REV. MR. SLOSS, MR. DONALD CAMPBELL of Mooresville to MISS ELIZABETH MCKINLEY, eldest daughter of COL. JOHN MCKINLEY (Florence Gazette).

January 17, 1838

Murder of COL. EDWARD WARD of Shelby County, Tennessee December 22nd, 1837 by the brothers, LAFAYETTE, CHAMBERLAYNE, DR. CAESER and ACHILLES JONES. (note by P.P.--EDWARD WARD moved from Davidson to Shelby County, Tennessee)

November 22, 1826
