January 16, 1819

Died lately at Mobile, MADAME MARY FONTINNELLE, at the very advanced age of 105, and for the last 70 years a resident of that place.

March 29, 1820

July 26, 1820

Married on the 21st June, GEORGE W. OWEN, Esq. of Claiborne to MISS LOUISA HOLLINGER of Baldwin County, Alabama.

Wednesday, 22nd ult., THOMAS ROGERS, Esq., Secretary of the State of Alabama.

January 2, 1819

Married on the same evening Thursday last by the REV. MR. HODGE, CAPT. B. B. JONES of the Alabama Territory, to MISS MARTHA HAYWOOD, daughter of JOHN HAYWOOD, Esq. of this county.

July 31, 1819

Died in this county on the 28th instant, BENJAMIN BRANCH.

Died on Thursday night, 22nd instant, the HON. JOHN HAYWOOD

December 3, 1835

Died suddenly in Triana, Alabama, HON. WM. J. ADAIR, Judge of the 5th Judicial Circuit in that State.

January 5, 1836

Married in Dresden (Weakley County), Tennessee DR. WM. H. JENKINS of Alabama to MISS ANN GLENN.

June 28, 1836

Died in the vicinity of this place, MRS. SUSANNAH C. PAINE, consort of REV. ROBERT PAINE, President of LaGrange College, Alabama.

July 19, 1836

Died in Florence, Alabama, MRS. MARTHA, consort of THOS. CHILDRESS, Esq., formerly of this place.

Died in Sumpter County, Alabama COL. THOMAS HENDERSON, late of Madison County, Tennessee.

June 13, 1835

Married in this place on Wednesday morning last (see marriage record volume 174, page 73), by the REV. MR. CUNNINGHAM, MR. WALTER B. WRIGHT to MISS PAULINE SNYDER, the armless lady, exhibited throughout the U.S. (Montgomery Advertiser).

June 4, 1835

Married in Courtland, Alabama MR. FELIX SHERROD to MISS SARAH A(NN), daughter of the late COL. JOEL PARRISH of this place (married May 28, 1835).
